

Rubric to evaluate your poster

Students who present posters in the virtual poster session will be evaluated in two areas:

1. Scientific Content (60%)
 1. Abstract - Informative and aligns with the scientific content of the poster (Your abstract has already been loaded into the web site).
 2. Scientific Content—Introduction and background with literature cited, objective of the study, materials and methods (study design), results and discussion, and significance to field. Quality of research will be judged on its scientific rigor and significance as conveyed by the poster. Be certain to address why the research was done and why the results are important. Poster displays must be self-explanatory. Judges will discuss poster displays with students via questions and such interaction is included in the evaluation of the display.
2. Poster Display and Organization (40%)
 1. Organization—Logical order, minimum redundancy, effective use of space.
 2. Text, Figures, and Tables—Legibility, grammar and spelling, and effective use of graphics
